01 Applicability

These terms apply to all quotations, agreements and assignments between Bas Uijlings Photography & Film and the client, unless otherwise agreed in writing.

02 Fees and Payment

The agreed fee is recorded in the quotation or order confirmation. Invoices must be paid within 14 days.

In the event of late payment, statutory interest plus 2% shall be due. Use or delivery of materials is not permitted while any outstanding invoices remain unpaid.

03 Reservation Fee

Upon confirmation, a reservation fee is due to secure the assignment date and exclusive availability.

The reservation fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.

04 Cancellation

Upon cancellation, the reservation fee remains fully due.

In addition, the following charges apply to the total assignment value:

More than 6 months before the assignment date	25%
Between 2 and 6 months before the assignment date	50%
Within 2 months of the assignment date	75%

If no package has been confirmed, the standard Mazzani package serves as the basis.

05 Execution

The client shall provide all relevant information in a timely manner. The photographer works according to their own creative and technical judgement, within the agreed framework.

The assignment constitutes a best-efforts obligation, not a results obligation.

06 Delivery and Complaints

Files are delivered in the agreed format and quality. Complaints must be submitted in writing within 10 working days of delivery.

07 Album Design and Approval

For assignments that include an album, an approval deadline applies to the album design, commencing on the delivery date of the images. Following receipt of the photography, the client has six months to submit their album design preferences. After this period, the following surcharges apply to the agreed package price:

6 to 12 months after delivery of photography	€ 150
12 to 24 months	€ 350
24 to 36 months	€ 750
More than 36 months	€ 1,000 + price difference

Surcharges are invoiced prior to album production and must be paid before the assignment enters production.

Bas Uijlings Photography & Film reserves the right to offer an alternative or to cancel the album order in the event of significant delay, in which case the amount already paid for the album is retained as compensation for reserved capacity.

08 Force Majeure

In the event of force majeure, including illness, a suitable solution will be sought in consultation. Work already performed and costs already incurred will be invoiced.

09 Copyright, Licence and Use

All intellectual property rights are vested in the photographer. The client receives only a personal, non-exclusive and non-transferable right of use, as agreed in writing.

Transfer or sublicensing to third parties is not permitted without prior written consent.

10 Editing of Images

Delivered works may not be edited, altered, filtered, cropped or otherwise modified without prior written consent.

11 Credit and Online Use

When publishing, credit must be given, preferably via @basuijlings. Works must remain unaltered and may not be placed in a misleading context.

12 Copyright Infringement

Use beyond the agreed licence constitutes copyright infringement. The client shall owe compensation of at least three times the standard licence fee, without prejudice to the right to full damages including legal costs.

In the absence of credit, an additional fee of at least 100% of the standard licence fee applies.

13 Publication and Privacy

By accepting these terms, the client grants permission for the publication of delivered works for promotional purposes of Bas Uijlings Photography & Film, unless otherwise agreed in writing.

Full discretion and a publication ban are available on a bespoke basis, for a separately agreed fee.

14 Data Protection and Archive

Personal data is processed solely for the purpose of executing the assignment, in accordance with the GDPR. Data is stored securely and never shared with third parties without explicit consent.

Delivered files are retained for a minimum of 2 years after delivery.

Extended archiving is available on a bespoke basis.

15 Liability

Liability is limited to the invoiced amount or the amount paid out by the insurer. The photographer is not liable for indirect damages, consequential loss or loss of profit.

16 Insolvency and Termination

Either party may terminate the agreement immediately in the event of bankruptcy or suspension of payments. Upon the client's bankruptcy, the right of use for delivered works lapses.

17 Governing Law

All legal relationships are governed by Dutch law. Disputes shall be submitted to the competent court in the Netherlands.
